The Better Internet for Kids (BIK) portal offers resources dedicated to understanding marketing in games. It explains how marketing strategies are embedded in online games and apps and offers practical advice on how to recognise these

tactics and help our children understand them. By using these tools, parents can better protect and guide their children while they are online.
