

Parents Meeting: What can you do to help at home?

Fred Talk

1. Speak like Fred throughout the day
2. Play Fred games
3. Use 'Fred Talk, read the word' to read words.

Set 1 Sounds:

1. Use pure sounds, not letter names
2. Teach the picture names
3. Practise reading sounds speedily - 'review, review, review'
4. Use the handwriting phrases for writing only.

Set 2 and 3 Sounds

1. Practise the sounds and phrases
2. Practise reading sounds speedily - 'review, review, review'
3. Use 'Special Friends', 'Fred Talk', 'read the word' to read words.

Reading stories to your child

1. Read the same stories aloud again and again
2. Read with enthusiasm – love each story
3. Use a range of vocabulary with your child.

Listening to your child read

1. Listen to your child read the same *Read Write Inc.* Storybook again and again.
2. Encourage them to use 'Special Friends', 'Fred Talk', 'read the word'.
3. Discuss the story and encourage their storyteller voice.
