Pupil Premium Funding



What is Pupil Premium funding? Funding to improve educational outcomes for disadvantaged pupils in schools in England.

How does Pupil Premium help our school and families? Funding is used to support high quality teaching, interventions, resources, curriculum enrichment (including 50% off residential visits) and it also provides pastoral care and support for children and families. Who is entitled to funding? The following groups are eligible for pupil premium:

- Pupil who are recorded as eligible for free school meals, or have been recorded as eligible in the past 6 years, including eligible children of families who have no resource to public funds.
- Children looked after by local authorities, referred to as looked after children.
- Children previously looked after by a local authority or other state care, referred to as previously looked after children

Who is entitled to Service Pupil Premium? The criteria is as follows:

- When one parent is serving in the regular armed forces.
- Registered as a 'service child' on any school census in the past 6 years.
- One of their parents died while serving in the armed forces and the pupil received a pension under the armed forces Compensation Scheme or the War Pensions Scheme.

How do I apply? Please collect a form from the school office.
